Dear Parents/Guardian of Preschool Children:

Our high school offers its students a course entitled Early Childhood Teaching Lab. Their experiences are gained through a laboratory preschool program we conduct. The preschool is for children who are three years old as of September 1, 2017. The child must live in Indian Prairie Community School District 204 to be eligible for the program. There will be a morning preschool which will meet on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, starting in mid-September and ending in May, 2017. There are 15 children who can be enrolled in the preschool session. Preschool will run from 9:20a.m. to 11:45a.m. on Mondays and Fridays and then 9:10a.m. to 11:30a.m. on Wednesdays. We will be using the following system for selection.

1. Parents fill out the registration form and either mail it back or drop it off by April 21, 2017.
2. Names will be randomly drawn for the preschool class. Parents of the selected children will be contacted by May 5, 2017. If not selected, parents will also be notified.
3. If your child is selected, a \$50.00 non-refundable registration/supply fee will be due by May 22, 2017.
4. The tuition for the program is \$100.00 for first semester. This will be payable in September at the orientation meeting. There will be an additional \$150 tuition/supply fee due at the beginning of second semester in February. The fees will cover classroom experiences and a preschool shirt.

The preschool itself is not a part of the public education programming of District 204. Waubonsie Valley offers this preschool lab primarily for the vocational benefit of the high school students enrolled in the Early Childhood Teaching Lab. For this reason, it is of the utmost importance that the preschoolers be in attendance on a regular basis and function at a level that high school students in such a course are reasonably equipped to handle. As you complete and return the application form, please keep this in mind.
